1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT RELATING TO THE MANNER OF ELECTION AND ORGANIZATION OF THE 3 BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF YANCEY COUNTY. 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5 SECTION 1. Effective on the first Monday in December of 2010, the Board of 6 Commissioners of Yancey County is expanded from three to five members, elected as follows: 7 In 2010 there shall be elected five members, the two persons receiving the 8 highest numbers of votes are elected for four-year terms, and the three 9 persons receiving the next highest numbers of votes are elected to two-year 10 terms. 11 In 2012 and biennially thereafter, there shall be elected three members, the (2) two persons receiving the highest numbers of votes are elected for four-year 12 terms, and the person receiving the next highest number of votes is elected to 13 14 a two-year term. **SECTION 2.** Beginning with the 2010 general election, the office of chairman of 15 16 the Board of Commissioners of Yancey County is abolished as a separately elective office. Instead, effective on the first Monday in December of 2010, the selection of chairman shall be 17 in accordance with G.S. 153A-39. 18 19 **SECTION 3.** Chapter 127 of the General Statutes, Public-Local Acts of 1923, is 20 repealed.

**SECTION 4.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
