SECTION 1. Article 3 of Chapter 95 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

"§ 95-28.4. Mandatory lunch breaks.

- The General Assembly finds that, for reasons of general health and safety, employees should be permitted to stop work at least once during the shift or workday for nutritional purposes.
- The Commissioner of Labor shall adopt rules to provide that, at a minimum, every employer must allow each employee to take at least one work break for a meal during the employee's workday or shift."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
