The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
<b>SECTION 1.</b> Notwithstanding the provisions of 15A NCAC 10B.0106(d)(5)
any other provision of law, wild animals of the order Carnivora and beaver that have been
taken alive under a depredation permit may be relocated to a suitable alternative habitat wi
the consent of the landowner of that new habitat.
SECTION 2. This got applies only to the City of Greenshore
