A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE U.S. NAVY SPECIALTY PLATE TO THE U.S. SUBMARINE VETERAN PLATE, TO CHANGE THE PHRASE ON THE PLATE, TO ADD MORE DETAIL TO THE REPRESENTATION OF THE QUALIFICATION PIN, AND TO REDUCE THE NUMBER OF APPLICATIONS REQUIRED BEFORE THE U.S. NAVY SUBMARINE VETERAN PLATE MAY BE PRODUCED.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 20-79.4(130) reads as rewritten:

"(130) U.S. Navy ~~Specialty~~Submarine Veteran. – Issuable to a veteran of the United States Navy ~~Submariner~~Submarine Service. The plate shall bear the phrase "~~Silent Service~~United States Navy Submarine Veteran" and shall bear a representation of the Submarine Service Qualification ~~pin~~insignia overlaid upon a representation of the State of North Carolina. The Division may not issue the plate authorized by this subdivision unless it receives at least ~~300~~150 applications for the plate."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
