The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 20-129(e) reads as rewritten:	
"(e) Lamps on Bicycles. – Every bicycle shall be equipped with a lighted lamp on t	the
front thereof, visible under normal atmospheric conditions from a distance of at least 300 fe	eet
in front of such bicycle, and shall also be equipped with a reflex mirror or lamp on the re	ar,
exhibiting a red light visible under like conditions from a distance of at least 200 feet to the re	ear
of such bicycle, when used at night.in operation during the period from sunset to sunrise or	n a
street, highway, or public vehicular area."	
<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act becomes effective December 1, 2009, and applies	to

offenses committed on or after that date.
