cut down, injure or remove any standing, growing or fallen tree or log, log off the property of		
another, he the person shall be guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor. criminal offense as follows:		
<u>(1</u>	) If the damage caused by a violation of this section is c	one thousand dollars
	(\$1,000) or less, then the offense is a Class 1 misdemean	or.
<u>(2</u>	2) If the damage caused by a violation of this section is more	re than one thousand
	dollars (\$1,000), then the offense is a Class I felony.	
<u>(b)</u> <u>S</u>	ubsection (a) of this section shall not apply to a lessee of prop	perty who removes a
fallen tree or log that poses an imminent threat to persons or property."		
S	ECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 20	009, and applies to
offenses com	umitted on or after that date.
