2	AN ACT TO EXEMPT TRAILERS USED BY FARMERS TO TRANSPORT LIVESTOCK
3	FROM VEHICLE REGISTRATION AND CERTIFICATE OF TITLE REQUIREMENTS,
4	INCLUDING THE FEES ASSOCIATED WITH THOSE REQUIREMENTS, WHEN THE
5	TRAILERS ARE USED TO TRANSPORT LIVESTOCK FROM FARM TO FARM OR
6	FROM FARM TO MARKET.
7	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
8	SECTION 1. G.S. 20-51(6) reads as rewritten:
9	"(6) Any trailer or semitrailer attached to and drawn by a properly licensed motor
10	vehicle when used by a farmer, his tenant, agent, or employee in transporting
11	livestock, unginned cotton, peanuts, soybeans, corn, hay, tobacco, silage,
12	cucumbers, potatoes, all vegetables, fruits, greenhouse and nursery plants
13	and flowers, Christmas trees, fertilizers or chemicals purchased or owned by
14	the farmer or tenant for personal use in implementing husbandry, irrigation
15	pipes, loaders, or equipment owned by the farmer or tenant from place to
16	place on the same farm, from one farm to another, from farm to gin, from
17	farm to dryer, or from farm to market, and when not operated on a for-hire
18	basis. The term "transporting" as used herein shall include the actual hauling
19	of said products and all unloaded travel in connection therewith."
20	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2012.
