The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Chapter 8 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new Article to read: "Article 16. "Insurance Coverage. "§ 8-115. Evidence of insurance coverage admissible. Notwithstanding G.S. 8C-1, Rule 411, in any civil proceeding, including the questioning of jurors under G.S. 9-15, counsel of record for the plaintiffs may present evidence or inquire regarding the existence, contents, and coverage of any liability insurance policies held by any defendant." **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective October 1, 2011, and applies to any cause
