SECTION 1. G.S. 143-215.1 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:		
"(a5) N	otwithstanding subsection (a) of this section, a permit shall not be require	red for a
wastewater management system for the treatment and disposal of wastewater produced from		
activities related to the processing of agricultural products if all of the following conditions are		
met:		
<u>(1</u>	The activities related to the processing of the agricultural prod	ucts are
	carried out by the owner of the agricultural products.	
<u>(2</u>	The activities related to the processing of the agricultural products	produce
	no more than 1,000 gallons of wastewater per day.	
<u>(3</u>	The wastewater is disposed of by land application.	
<u>(4</u>	No wastewater is discharged to surface waters.	
<u>(5</u>	The disposal of the wastewater does not result in any violation of	f surface
	water or groundwater standards."	
SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
