The General Asse	embly of North Carolina enacts:
SECT	<b>TION 1.</b> G.S. 143-215.1 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
" <u>(a5)</u> For p	burposes of this subsection, "agricultural products" means horticultural,
viticultural, forestry, dairy, livestock, poultry, bee, and any farm products. Notwithstanding	
	this section, a permit shall not be required for a wastewater management
	reatment and disposal of wastewater produced from activities related to the
processing of agricultural products if all of the following conditions are met:	
<u>(1)</u>	The activities related to the processing of the agricultural products are
	carried out by the owner of the agricultural products.
<u>(2)</u>	The activities related to the processing of the agricultural products produce
	no more than 1,000 gallons of wastewater per day.
<u>(3)</u>	The wastewater is not generated by an animal waste management system as
	<u>defined in G.S. 143-215.10B.</u>
<u>(4)</u>	The wastewater is disposed of by land application.
<u>(5)</u>	No wastewater is discharged to surface waters.
<u>(6)</u>	The disposal of the wastewater does not result in any violation of surface
	water or groundwater standards."
SECT	<b>TION 2.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
