- 2 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE RETRIEVAL OF KILLED OR WOUNDED DEER USING 3 A SINGLE DOG ON A LEASH.
- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
 - **SECTION 1.** G.S. 113-291.1 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
 - If a hunter kills or wounds a deer during the hunting hours authorized by subsection "(k)
- 6 (a) of this section, the hunter may use a handheld light and a single dog on a leash to assist the 7
- 8 hunter in retrieving the dead or wounded deer, and may dispatch a wounded deer using only a
- .22-caliber rimfire pistol or a weapon otherwise legal for that hunting season. Pursuit and 9
- retrieval under this subsection may occur after the hunting hours provided for in subsection (a) 10
- of this section if necessary, but such pursuit and retrieval may not be accomplished using a 11
- 12 motor vehicle.
- For purposes of this section, the term "dispatch" means the quick and humane killing of a 13
- 14 wounded animal to prevent further suffering through infection, starvation, or other distress in 15 the wild."
- 16 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective October 1, 2011.
