1 **SECTION 3.** The Commission shall study issues related to Public-Private 2 Partnerships (PPPs), including examination of the appropriate authority for State, regional, and 3 local government units to engage in PPPs for public capital projects through a regulatory 4 framework. As part of its study, the Commission may study infrastructure banks and any other 5 relevant issues it deems appropriate.

6 **SECTION 4.** The Commission may report its recommendations and legislative 7 proposals to the 2012 Regular Session of the 2011 General Assembly on or before its 8 convening.
