(Public) Sponsors: Referred to: March 15, 2011 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT AUTHORIZING A HOUSING AUTHORITY TO COLLECT UNPAID DELINQUENT DEBT BY SETTING OFF THE DEBT AGAINST A STATE INCOME TAX REFUND DUE A TENANT OR FORMER TENANT OF THE HOUSING AUTHORITY. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** G.S. 105A-2(6) reads as rewritten: Local agency. – Any of the following: A county, to the extent it is not considered a State agency. a. A municipality. b. A water and sewer authority created under Article 1 of Chapter 162A c. of the General Statutes. A regional joint agency created by interlocal agreement under Article d. 20 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes between two or more counties, cities, or both. A public health authority created under Part 1B of Article 2 of e. Chapter 130A of the General Statutes or other authorizing legislation. A metropolitan sewerage district created under Article 5 of Chapter f. 162A of the General Statutes. A sanitary district created under Part 2 of Article 2 of Chapter 130A g. of the General Statutes. A housing authority created under Chapter 157 of the General h. Statutes, provided that the debt owed to a housing authority has been reduced to a final judgment in favor of the housing authority."
