The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
SECTION 1. It is unlawful to hunt with a centerfire rifle except from a platform	
which raises the lower level of the barrel to a minimum of eight feet above ground level. For	or
purposes of this act, the term "hunt" is defined as provided in G.S. 113-130.	
SECTION 2. Section 1 of this act does not apply to a landowner or lessee of	эf
property using a centerfire rifle for self-protection or to prevent crop depredation.	
SECTION 3. A person who violates Section 1 of this act is responsible for a	ın
infraction and shall pay a penalty of ten dollars (\$10.00) plus court costs.	
SECTION 4. This act is enforceable by law enforcement officers of the Wildlif	fe
Resources Commission, by sheriffs and deputy sheriffs, and by peace officers with general	al
subject matter jurisdiction.	
SECTION 5. This act applies only to Pasquotank County.	

SECTION 6. This act becomes effective October 1, 2011, and applies to acts committed on or after that date.
