AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE COUNTIES THAT PROVIDE ELECTRONIC MONITORING
FOR OFFENDERS TO COLLECT A FEE TO RECOVER THE ACTUAL COSTS OF
PROVIDING THAT MONITORING.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
<b>SECTION 1.</b> Article 28 of Chapter 7A of the General Statutes is amended by
adding a new section to read:
"§ 7A-313.1. Fee for costs of electronic monitoring.
A county that provides the personnel, equipment, and other costs of providing electronic
monitoring as a condition of an offender's bond or pretrial release may collect a fee from the
offender that is the lesser of the amount of the jail fee authorized in G.S. 7A-313 or the actual
cost of providing the electronic monitoring. A county may not collect a fee from an offender
who is determined to be indigent and entitled to court-appointed counsel."

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2011.
