In any action in which a city or county is a party, upon a finding by the cour	t that the city or
county acted outside the scope of its legal authority, the court may award reason	onable attorneys'
fees and costs to the party who successfully challenged the city's or county's a	action, provided
that if the court also finds that the city's or county's action was an abuse of it	s discretion, the
court shall award attorneys' fees and costs."	
<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act becomes effective October 1, 2011, and appl	ies to claims for

relief which are brought or defended on or after that date.
