2 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES TO 3 EVALUATE AND REPORT SEMIANNUALLY ON THE EFFICACY OF THE 4 CRITICAL MODEL, ACCESS BEHAVIORAL HEALTH AGENCY AS 5 RECOMMENDED BY THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE ON 6 MENTAL HEALTH, DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES, AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE 7 SERVICES.

8 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

9 **SECTION 1.(a)** By July 1, 2011, the Division of Mental Health, Developmental 10 Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services of the Department of Health and Human Services 11 (Division) shall report to the Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on Mental Health, 12 Developmental Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services on the criteria and processes used 13 by the Division to evaluate the fiscal, organizational, and programmatic efficacy of 14 implementing the Critical Access Behavioral Health Agency (CABHA) category of provider 15 agency.

16 **SECTION 1.(b)** Beginning October 1, 2011, and every six months thereafter, the 17 Division shall submit a report to the Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on Mental Health, 18 Developmental Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services evaluating the fiscal, organizational, 19 and programmatic efficacy of the CABHA category of provider agency using the criteria and 20 processes identified by the Division in the report authorized by Section 1(a) of this act.

21 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.



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
