A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE FULL-SERVICE COMMUNITY SCHOOLS PILOT 3 PROGRAM.
- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 SECTION 1. The Department of Public Instruction shall establish a full-service 6 community schools pilot program in at least five middle or high schools. The purpose of a full-7 service community school is to encourage the coordination of academic, social, and health 8 services among schools, community-based organizations, nonprofit organizations, and other 9 public and private agencies to provide comprehensive academic, social, and health services for 10 students, students' family members, and community members that will result in improved educational outcomes for children. Services offered in the pilot schools may include, but are 11 12 not limited to:

- 13 (1)Family engagement, including parental involvement, parent leadership, family literacy, and parent education programs. 14 Mentoring and other youth development programs. 15 (2)
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 - Community service and service learning programs. (3)
- Job training and career counseling. 17 (4)
- 18 Nutrition services, physical activities, access to health and dental care. (5)
- 19 (6) Financial literacy.
- 20 Mental and social health services. (7)
 - Adult education, including English as a second language. (8)
- SECTION 2. The Department of Public Instruction shall report to the Joint 22 23 Legislative Education Oversight Committee by July 15, 2012, on the costs and benefits of the 24 pilot schools.
- 25 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
