| 4 | Whereas, North Carolina ranks ninth in the nation for the percentage of persons that |
| 5 | require kidney replacement therapy for kidney failure; and |
| 6 | Whereas, North Carolina spends five billion dollars per year on kidney |
| 7 | disease-related health expenses; and |
| 8 | Whereas, one in nine North Carolinians is at risk for developing chronic kidney |
| 9 | disease (CKD); and |
| 10 | Whereas, an increasing number of North Carolinians are at risk for developing CKD |
| 11 | due to our aging population, our level of obesity, plus the complications of diabetes and |
| 12 | hypertension; and |
| 13 | Whereas, almost half of those who currently have CKD may have been able to |
| 14 | prevent contracting this disease had they known the risk factors; and |
| 15 | Whereas, early detection and treatment of CKD may prevent undue suffering, the |
| 16 | need for dialysis treatments, and kidney transplantation, and decrease the financial burden of |
| 17 | CKD on the State; and |
| 18 | Whereas, the month of March is recognized as National Kidney Month; and |
| 19 | Whereas, observing the month of March as Kidney Month in the State of North |
| 20 | Carolina would help to promote public awareness of CKD; Now, therefore, |
| 21 | The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: |
| 22 | SECTION 1. Chapter 103 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new |
| 23 | section to read: |
| 24 | " <u>§ 103-12. Kidney Month.</u> |
| 25 | The month of March of each year is designated as Kidney Month in North Carolina." |
| 26 | SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law. |
