1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT ESTABLISHING THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, DIVISION OF SOCIAL SERVICES, SHALL NOT REQUIRE A REDETERMINATION OF ELIGIBILITY FOR VENDOR PAYMENTS UNDER AN ADOPTION ASSISTANCE AGREEMENT UNLESS THE AGREEMENT SPECIFIES THAT A REDETERMINATION OF ELIGIBILITY IS REQUIRED, UNDER THE LAWS REGULATING PROGRAMS OF PUBLIC ASSISTANCE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Part 4 of Article 2 of Chapter 108A of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

"§ 108A-50.3. No redetermination of adoption assistance agreements required; limitations.

Except as otherwise prohibited by federal law, the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Social Services, shall not require a redetermination of eligibility for vendor payments under an adoption assistance agreement unless the adoption assistance agreement specifically states that a redetermination of eligibility is required to receive the vendor payments."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
