A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT BIDS AND DOCUMENTS RELATED TO BIDS AND
CONTRACTS FOR PROJECTS OFFERED FOR BID BY THE DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION ARE NOT PUBLIC RECORDS UNTIL THE CONTRACT FOR
THE PROJECT IS AWARDED.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 136-28.5 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
"(c) Notwithstanding G.S. 132-1, bids and documents submitted in response to an
advertisement or request for proposal under this Chapter shall not be public record until the
Department issues a decision to award or not to award the contract."
<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act becomes effective July 1, 2011, and applies to bids and
documents submitted for advertisements and requests for proposal that are advertised or
requested on or after that date.
