31	Statutes, the structure of the Guilford County Board of Commissioners shall not be altered
32	under that Part prior to July 1, 2017.
33	"SECTION 3.(i) The Guilford County Commissioners shall submit the changes required
34	by this act to the U.S. Department of Justice pursuant to section 5 of the Voting Rights Act of
35	
36	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
