The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Chapter 90 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new Article to read: "Article 10B. "Practice of Midwifery by Certified Professional Midwives. "§ 90-178.10. Practice of midwifery by certified professional midwife. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, any person who holds a current ministerial or tocological certification from an organization accredited by the Institute for Credentialing Excellence (ICE) may provide services as described in 42 U.S.C. § 1396r-6(b)(4)(E)(ii)(l)."
