- 8 SECTION 1. G.S. 20-79(d)(5) is amended by adding a new sub-subdivision to 9 read:
- 10 "(d) Restrictions on Use. - A dealer license plate may be displayed only on a motor vehicle that meets all of the following requirements: 11 12
- 13 (5) Is driven on a highway by a person who meets one of the following descriptions: 14 15
- 16 Is an employee of a dealer that employs at all times no less than 10 <u>g.</u> 17 motor vehicle sales representatives who are required to be licensed under Article 12 of this Chapter." 18 19
  - **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
