8	SECTION 1. The House of Representatives urges Congress to enact
9	comprehensive immigration reform.
10	SECTION 2. The Principal Clerk shall transmit a certified copy of this resolution
11	to the President and Vice President of the United States, the Majority and Minority Leader of
12	the United States Senate, and the Speaker and Minority Leader of the United States House of
13	Representatives, and to each member of Congress elected from the State of North Carolina.
14	SECTION 3. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
