SECTION 1. G.S. 143C-1-2(b) reads as rewritten:

"(b) Reversions. – Unless otherwise provided by law, at the end of the fiscal year the unexpended, unencumbered balance of an appropriation reverts to the fund from which the appropriation was made; except that (i) an appropriation to the General Assembly shall not revert unless otherwise provided by the Legislative Services Commission, (ii) an appropriation for a capital improvement project shall revert as provided by G.S. 143C-8-11, and—(iii) an appropriation for the implementation of information technology (IT) projects shall not revert until the project is implemented or abandoned. abandoned, and (iv) an appropriation for allotment to local school administrative units and charter schools shall not revert."

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective June 30, 2013.
