<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 90-108(b) reads as rewritten:		
"(b) Ar	ny person who violates this section shall be guilty of a Class 1 misd	emeanor.
Provided, that	t if the criminal pleading alleges that the violation was committed inter	ntionally,
and upon tria	al it is specifically found that the violation was committed intentiona	lly, such
violations sha	all be a Class I Class G felony. A person who violates subdivision	on (7) of
subsection (a	) of this section and also fortifies the structure, with the intent to im	pede law
enforcement e	entry, (by barricading windows and doors) shall be punished as a Class I	elon."
SE	ECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2013, and a	pplies to
offenses com	mitted on or after that date.
