A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO ALLOW THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO REMOVE THE 3 ADDITIONAL FEE FOR SPECIAL PLATES BASED UPON MILITARY SERVICE.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 20-79.7(a) reads as rewritten:

"§ 20-79.7. Fees for special registration plates and distribution of the fees.

Fees. - Upon request, the Division shall provide and issue free of charge a single 7 Legion of Valor, 100% Disabled Veteran, and Ex-Prisoner of War registration plate to a 8 9 recipient of a Legion of Valor award, a 100% disabled veteran, and an ex-prisoner of war each year. The preceding special registration plates are subject to the regular motor vehicle 10 registration fees in G.S. 20-88, if the registered weight of the vehicle is greater than 6,000 11 pounds. All other special registration plates are subject to the regular motor vehicle registration 12 fee in G.S. 20-87 or G.S. 20-88 plus an additional fee in the following amount: 13
