4	SECTION 1.(a) Chapter 126 of the General Statutes, the State Personnel Act, i
5	hereby renamed and may be cited as the "North Carolina Human Resources Act."
6	<b>SECTION 1.(b)</b> The following entities and positions created by Chapter 126 of the
7	General Statutes are hereby renamed by this act:
8	(1) The State Personnel Commission is renamed the "North Carolina Human
9	Resources Commission."
10	(2) The Office of State Personnel is renamed the "North Carolina Office of State
11	Human Resources."
12	(3) The State Personnel Director is renamed the Director of the North Carolin
13	Office of State Human Resources.
14	<b>SECTION 1.(c)</b> Modification of References. – The Revisor of Statutes shall delete
15	any reference in the General Statutes to the State Personnel Act, State Personnel Commission
16	the State Personnel Director, or the Office of State Personnel, or any derivative thereof, and
17	substitute references to the North Carolina Human Resources Act, the State Human Resource
18	Commission, the Director of the Office of State Human Resources, and the Office of Human

**SECTION 4.** Any business or other matter undertaken or commanded by the former State Personnel Commission, State Personnel Director, or Office of State Personnel regarding any State program, office, or contract or pertaining to or connected with their respective functions, powers, obligations, and duties that are pending on the date this act becomes effective may be conducted and completed by the Commission, Director, or Office in the same manner and under the same terms and conditions and with the same effect as if conducted and completed by the former commission, director, or office.

**SECTION 5.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2013.
