A JOINT RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR ADJOURNING THE 2013 REGULAR SESSION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO A DATE CERTAIN AND LIMITING THE MATTERS THAT MAY BE CONSIDERED UPON RECONVENING, PROVIDING FOR A SUBSEQUENT ADJOURNMENT TO A DATE CERTAIN AND LIMITING THE MATTERS THAT MAY BE CONSIDERED UPON RECONVENING, AND PROVIDING FOR ADJOURNMENT SINE DIE OF THE 2013 REGULAR SESSION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

Be it resolved by the Senate, the House of Representatives concurring:

SECTION 1. When the Senate and the House of Representatives adjourn on Saturday, August 2, 2014, they stand adjourned to reconvene on Thursday, August 14, 2014, at 12:00 noon.

SECTION 2. During the Regular Session that reconvenes on Thursday, August 14, 2014, only the following matters may be considered:

- (1) Bills returned by the Governor with his objections under Section 22 of Article II of the Constitution of North Carolina, but solely for the purpose of considering overriding of the veto upon reconsideration of the bill.
- (2) Bills relating to claims or orders in litigation to which the State, its instrumentalities, or its officers are parties.
- (3) Bills in which the General Assembly makes an appointment or appointments to public office and which contain no other matter.

SECTION 3. When the Senate and the House of Representatives adjourn on Friday, August 15, 2014, they stand adjourned to reconvene on Monday, November 17, 2014, at 6:00 p.m.

SECTION 4. During the Regular Session that reconvenes on Monday, November 17, 2014, only the following matters may be considered:

- (1) Bills related to the structure, operation, and funding of Medicaid.
- (2) Bills relating to claims or orders in litigation to which the State, its instrumentalities, or its officers are parties.
- (3) Bills returned by the Governor with his objections under Section 22 of Article II of the Constitution of North Carolina, but solely for the purpose of considering overriding of the veto upon reconsideration of the bill.
- (4) Confirmations pursuant to G.S. 7A-45.1(a10) if it becomes law.
- (5) Bills relating to coal ash management.
- (6) Bills in which the General Assembly makes an appointment or appointments to public office and which contain no other matter.
