9 INTRODUCTION

10 **SECTION 1.1.** The appropriations made in this act are for maximum amounts 11 necessary to provide the services and accomplish the purposes described in the budget. Savings 12 shall be affected where the total amounts appropriated are not required to perform these services 13 and accomplish these purposes, and the savings shall revert to the appropriate fund at the end of 14 each fiscal year, except as otherwise provided by G.S. 143C-1-2(b).

16 TITLE OF ACT

SECTION 1.2. This act shall be known as the "Current Operations and Capital
Improvements Appropriations Act of 2016."

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1 SECTION 6.4. If any section or provision of this act is declared unconstitutional or 2 invalid by the courts, it does not affect the validity of this act as a whole or any part other than the part so declared to be unconstitutional or invalid.

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5 **EFFECTIVE DATE**

SECTION 6.5. Except as otherwise provided, this act becomes effective July 1, 2016.
