1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO REAUTHORIZE THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO PRODUCE A
3	SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE FOR MILITARY VETERANS AND REMOVE THE
4	REQUIREMENT THAT THE DIVISION MUST RECEIVE A MINIMUM NUMBER OF
5	APPLICATIONS BEFORE ISSUING THE PLATE.
6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	SECTION 1. G.S. 20-79.4(b)(122), as it existed on September 30, 2014, is
8	reenacted.
9	SECTION 2. G.S. 20-79.4(b)(122), as reenacted by Section 1 of this act, reads as
10	rewritten:
11	"(b) Types. – The Division shall issue the following types of special registration plates:
12	····
13	(122) Military Veteran Issuable to an individual who served honorably in the
14	Armed Forces of the United States. The plate shall bear the words "U.S.
15	Military Veteran" and the name and insignia of the branch of service in
16	which the individual served. The Division may not issue the plate authorized
17	by this subdivision unless it receives at least 300 applications for the
18	plate. The plate authorized by this subdivision is not subject to the provisions
19	of G.S. 20-79.3A or G.S. 20-79.8."
20	SECTION 3. The fee amount set for "Military Veteran" special registration plates
21	in G.S. 20-79.7(a1) is reenacted.
22	SECTION 4. This act becomes effective 90 days after it becomes law.
