- 1 **SECTION 1.** Chapter 145 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section 2 to read: 3 "§ 145-48. Official Veterans Day Parade.
- The Veterans Day Parade held in the Town of Warsaw is adopted as the official Veterans Day Parade in the State of North Carolina." 5
- **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
