A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT DIRECTING THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO STUDY A PUBLIC-PRIVATE HOSPITAL PARTNERSHIP TO INCREASE ACCESS TO MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES; AND ALLOWING STATE-OPERATED HOSPITALS TO TRANSFER BEDS TO PRIVATE, RURAL HOSPITALS WITHOUT CERTIFICATE OF NEED REVIEW IN ORDER TO INCREASE ACCESS TO MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.(a)** The Legislative Research Commission (LRC) shall study the feasibility and effectiveness of establishing a partnership between State-operated hospitals and private, underutilized rural hospitals for the purpose of increasing access to services for the diagnosis and treatment of individuals with mental illness.

**SECTION 1.(b)** The LRC shall report its findings, together with any recommended legislation, to the 2016 Regular Session of the 2015 General Assembly upon its convening.

**SECTION 2.** G.S. 131E-176(16)c. reads as rewritten:

'(16) "New institutional health services" means any of the following:

c. Any change in bed capacity as defined in G.S. 131E-176(5). G.S. 131E-176(5), except for a change in bed capacity that results from the transfer of beds from a State-operated hospital to a private, rural hospital for the purpose of providing services for the diagnosis and treatment of individuals with mental illness.

**SECTION 3.** Section 1 of this act is effective when this act becomes law. Section 2 of this act becomes effective October 1, 2015, and applies to changes in bed capacity occurring on or after that date.
