BILL SUMMARY:

The bill amends G.S. 7A-60, District attorneys and prosecutorial districts, to increase the assistant district attorney (ADA) positions in District 9, Franklin, Granville, Vance, and Warren counties, from ten ADAs to eleven ADAs.

ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY:

The bill adds one assistant district attorney position to District 9. Total costs in the first year will be \$123,942. Costs shown in the table above have been increased for inflation according to rates provided by Moody's economy.com in January, 2017. Nonrecurring costs are only shown in the first year.

The Administrative Office of the Courts provides salary and operating cost information for most court positions. S.L. 2016-94, 2016 Appropriations Act, set the ADA salary allotment at \$76,073. Total salary and benefits for an ADA are \$99,974 (\$76,073 salary plus \$5,820 social security plus \$12,422 retirement plus \$5,659 health care).

In addition to the salary and benefit costs, there are operating costs for these positions. Total operating costs in the first year will be \$23,968, including \$3,752 in nonrecurring costs. The following table lists the operating costs associated with an assistant district attorney position.
