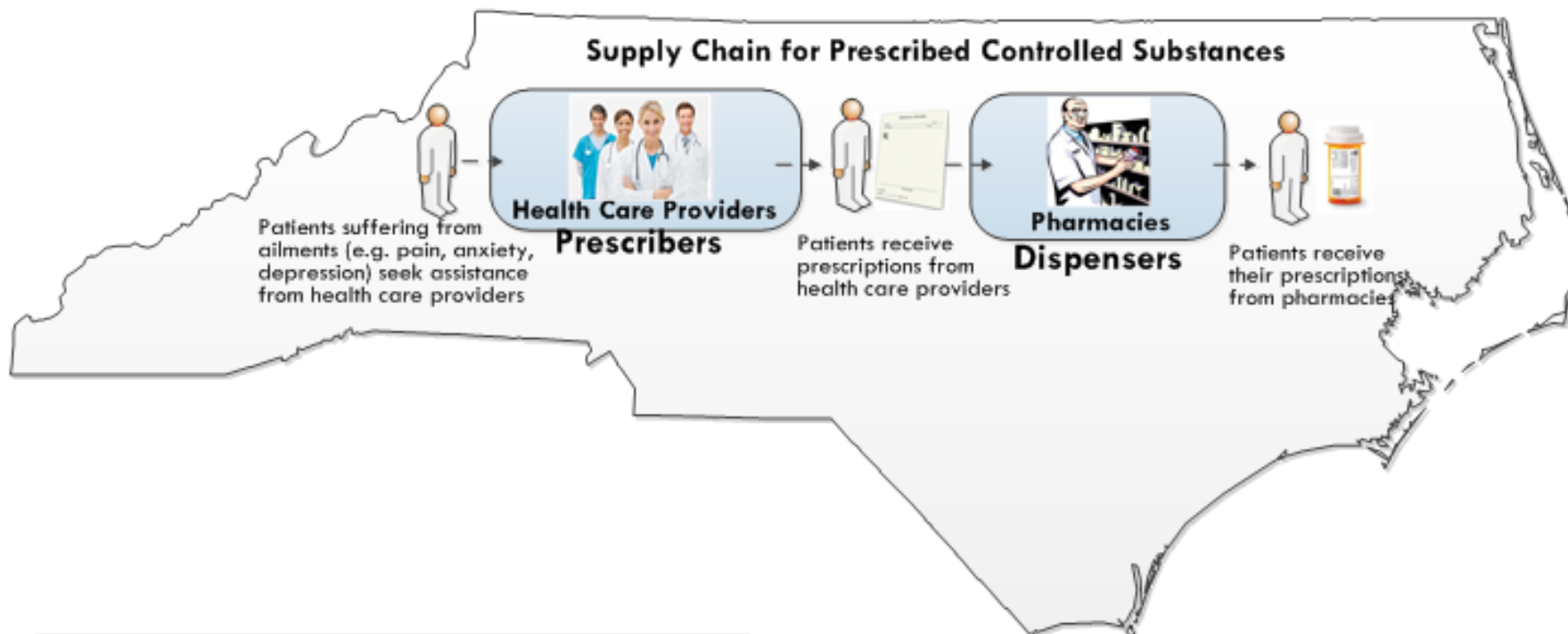


# 1. The Supply Chain and Mechanisms for Monitoring the Abuse of Prescribed Controlled Substances

**Oversight of Prescribers and Dispensers** Health care regulatory boards ensure clinical care standards are being met through licensure, guidelines, and continuing education of health care providers

**Prescription Drug Monitoring Program** The CSRS is the statewide electronic reporting system established to improve the state's ability to identify individuals, prescribers, and dispensers who abuse and misuse Schedule II-V prescribed controlled substances



**Medicaid lock-in** The lock-in program is intended to prevent overutilization of controlled substances within the Medicaid program and to improve safety and coordination of care

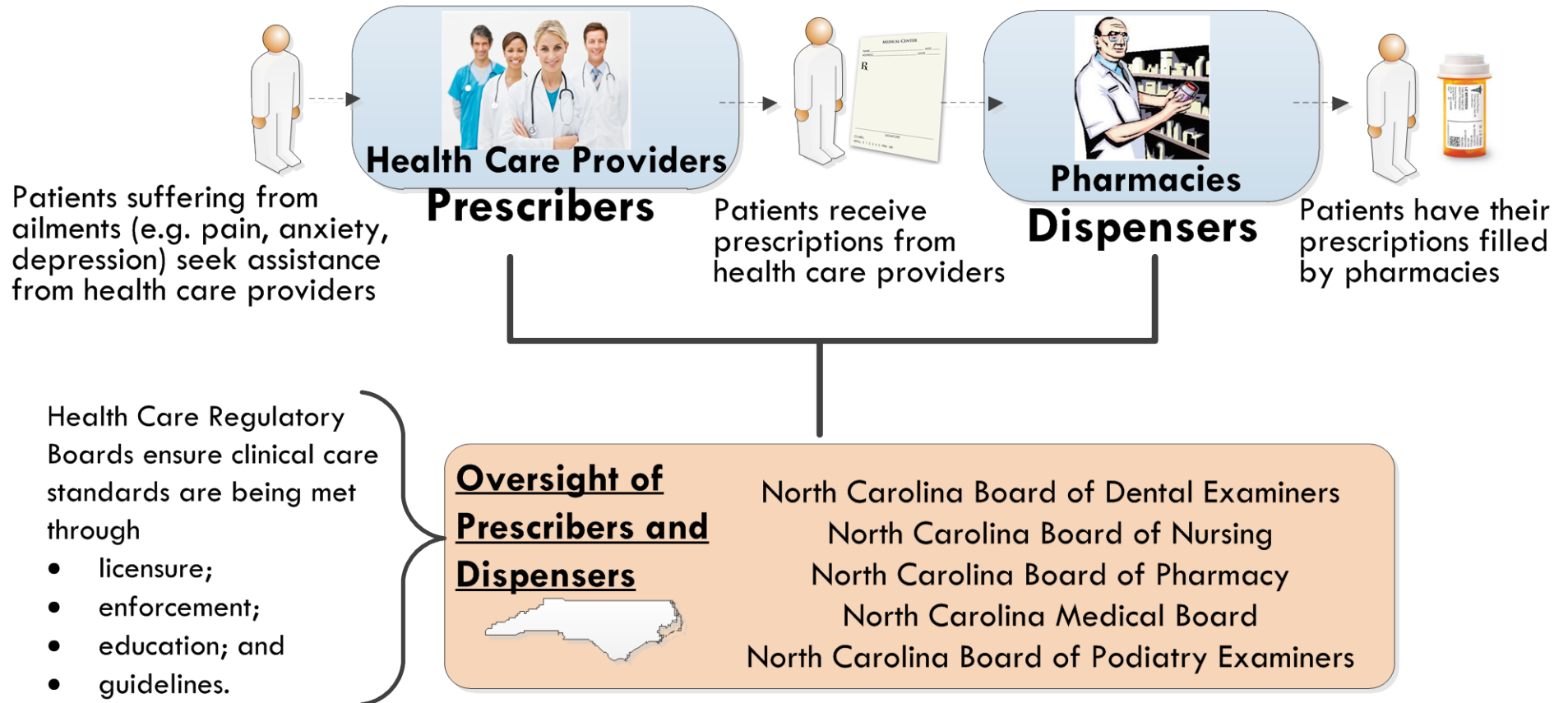
**Law Enforcement** The SBI's Diversion and Environmental Crimes Unit investigates the diversion of prescribed controlled substances by licensed prescribers, dispensers, and individuals
