G.S. 20-140.4(a) reads as rewritten: No person shall operate a motorcycle or moped upon a highway or public "(a) vehicular area: **(1)** When the number of persons upon such motorcycle or moped, including the operator, shall exceed the number of persons which it was designed to carry. Unless the operator and all passengers thereon wear safety helmets of a (2) type approved by the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles. Vehicles, except
