### A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	AN ACT ADOPTING THE STRAWBERRY AS THE OFFICIAL FRUIT OF NORTH
3	CAROLINA.
4	Whereas, strawberries are a good source of vitamins A, C, and B6 as well as a
5	number of life-sustaining minerals; and
6	Whereas, there are over 1,600 acres of strawberries grown in North Carolina;
7	and
8	Whereas, in 1999, strawberry growers across the State produced 17,600,000
9	pounds of strawberries, yielding \$14,080,000 in revenues; and
10	Whereas, the State of North Carolina does not have an official fruit; Now,
11	therefore,
12	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
13	<b>SECTION 1.</b> Chapter 145 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a
14	new section to read:
15	" <u>§ 145-18. State fruit.</u>
16	The strawberry is adopted as the official fruit of the State of North Carolina."
17	<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
