**SECTION 3.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial Department the sum of four hundred eleven thousand nine hundred thirty-three dollars (\$411,933) for the 2001-2002 fiscal year and the sum of three hundred seventy thousand five hundred twelve dollars (\$370,512) for the 2002-2003 fiscal year to establish the three new district court judges provided for in this act.

**SECTION 4.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2001.
