| 5  | The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:  |
| 6  | SECTION 1. If House Bill 275 is enacted, the Department of Health and                   |
| 7  | Human Services, Division of Public Health, shall develop a media campaign to inform     |
| 8  | the public of the provisions of House Bill 275. This media campaign shall contain       |
| 9  | information on responsible parenting in addition to information about the provisions of |
| 10 | House Bill 275. This media campaign shall be targeted at adolescents and young adults.  |
| 11 | This media campaign shall be developed in consultation with law enforcement officials,  |
| 12 | local departments of social services, medical personnel, and school administrators.     |
| 13 | <b>SECTION 2.</b> There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of one            |
| 14 | hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) for the 2001-2002 fiscal year and the sum of |
| 15 | one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) for the 2002-2003 fiscal year to the     |
| 16 | Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health, to implement the    |
| 17 | provisions of Section 1 of this act.  |
