A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO INCREASE THE MEDICAID REIMBURSEMENT RATE FOR
DENTAL CARE FOR MEDICAID ELIGIBLE CHILDREN AND ADULTS.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the
Department of Health and Human Services the sum of eleven million eight hundred
seventy-six thousand seven hundred thirteen dollars (\$11,876,713) for the 2001-2002
fiscal year and the sum of fourteen million one hundred seventy thousand one hundred
seventy-six dollars (\$14,170,176) for the 2002-2003 fiscal year. The Department shall
use these funds to increase rates for dental services under the Medicaid program for
Medicaid eligible children under the age of 21 to the eightieth (80 <sup>th</sup> ) percentile of
charges based on the 2000 survey by the National Dental Advisory Services
organization. The Department shall develop a fee schedule to implement the rate
increase authorized under this section. The Department shall structure the fee schedule
to ensure that funds appropriated in this section are used to best serve the Medicaid
population. In developing the fee schedule, the Department shall consult with the North
Carolina Dental Society and the Old North State Dental Society.
<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act becomes effective October 1, 2001.
