2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A MARTIN
3	LUTHER KING, JR. AMPHITHEATER AND PARK IN CUMBERLAND
4	COUNTY.
5	Whereas, the Martin Luther King, Jr. Committee in Cumberland County has
6	proposed building an amphitheater and park honoring the late civil rights leader; and
7	Whereas, the amphitheater and park would promote the observance of the
8	Martin Luther King, Jr. Holiday and enhance the awareness of Dr. King's life and work;
9	and
10	Whereas, funds are needed to assist the Committee with the construction;
11	Now, therefore,
12	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
13	<b>SECTION 1.</b> There is appropriated from the General Fund to Cumberland
14	County the sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for the 2001-2002 fiscal
15	year to be used by the Martin Luther King, Jr. Committee for the construction of the
16	Martin Luther King, Jr. Amphitheater and Park. These funds may also be used to create
17	and construct a statue of Dr. King and to landscape the park, including creating gardens
18	and constructing a water fountain.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2001.
