2 AN ACT ELIMINATING THE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT FOR POLICE3 OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF ROCKY MOUNT.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** Section 140(a) of the Charter of the City of Rocky Mount, 6 being Chapter 938 of the 1963 Session Laws, as amended by Chapter 427 of the 1969 7 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:

8 "(a) The City Manager shall appoint the Chief of Police. The Chief of Police, 9 acting under the City Manager, shall appoint the other police officers of the City and 10 shall have supervision and control of the police force and shall enforce discipline 11 therein. Police officers shall be residents of Nash or Edgecombe Counties, but need not 12 be residents of the City."
