A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT INCREASING THE FORCE ACCOUNT LIMIT OF THE CITY OF 3 ASHEVILLE.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 143-135 reads as rewritten:

6 "§ 143-135. Limitation of application of Article.

Except for the provisions of G.S. 143-129 requiring bids for the purchase of 7 8 apparatus, supplies, materials or equipment, this Article shall not apply to construction or repair work undertaken by the State or by subdivisions of the State of North Carolina 9 (i) when the work is performed by duly elected officers or agents using force account 10 11 qualified labor on the permanent payroll of the agency concerned and (ii) when either 12 the total cost of the project, including without limitation all direct and indirect costs of 13 labor, services, materials, supplies and equipment, does not exceed one hundred twenty-14 five thousand dollars (\$125,000) three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) or the total cost of labor on the project does not exceed fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000). This force 15 16 account work shall be subject to the approval of the Director of the Budget in the case 17 of State agencies, of the responsible commission, council, or board in the case of subdivisions of the State. Complete and accurate records of the entire cost of such work, 18 including without limitation, all direct and indirect costs of labor, services, materials, 19 20 supplies and equipment performed and furnished in the prosecution and completion thereof, shall be maintained by such agency, commission, council or board for the 21 22 inspection by the general public. Construction or repair work undertaken pursuant to 23 this section shall not be divided for the purposes of evading the provisions of this 24 Article."

SECTION 2.(a) This act applies to the City of Asheville only.

26 **SECTION 2.(b)** This act applies only to the construction of a skateboard 27 park on Cherry Street.

28 SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law and expires June 30,
29 2003.
