A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF DURHAM TO REQUIRE OWNERS OF
3 LANDMARKS AND BUILDINGS WITHIN HISTORIC DISTRICTS TO
4 MAINTAIN THEIR PROPERTY IN GOOD CONDITION.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** The Charter of the City of Durham, being Chapter 671 of the 7 1975 Session Laws, as amended, is further amended by adding the following new 8 section:

9 "Sec. 94.7. Maintenance of Landmarks and Historic Buildings.

10 The City may enact ordinances requiring owners of designated landmarks or 11 buildings, structures, or sites within historic districts to maintain their property in good 12 condition. Any ordinances adopted under this section shall contain appropriate 13 safeguards to protect owners if the required maintenance would cause undue economic 14 hardship."

15 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
