2	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF DURHAM TO REQUIRE OWNERS OF
3	LANDMARKS AND BUILDINGS WITHIN HISTORIC DISTRICTS TO
4	MAINTAIN THEIR PROPERTY IN GOOD CONDITION AND TO PROHIBIT
5	THE TAKING OF DEER WITH DOGS IN DURHAM COUNTY.
6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	SECTION 1. The Charter of the City of Durham, being Chapter 671 of the
8	1975 Session Laws, as amended, is further amended by adding the following new
9	section:
10	"Sec. 94.7. Maintenance of Landmarks and Historic Buildings.
11	The City may enact ordinances requiring owners of designated landmarks or owners
12	of contributing buildings, structures, or sites within historic districts to maintain their
13	property in good condition. Any ordinances adopted under this section shall contain
14	appropriate safeguards to protect owners if the required maintenance would cause undue
15	economic hardship."
16	SECTION 2. Section 1 of Chapter 669 of the 1993 Session Laws reads as
17	rewritten:
18	"Section 1. It is unlawful to take deer with the aid of dogs, unless the hunter has in
19	his possession written permission of the owner of the land to take deer with dogs, and
20	provided that the land is located within the geographic area designated by the Wildlife
21	Resources Commission as an area in which taking deer with dogs is permitted. dogs."
22	SECTION 3. Section 1 of this act applies only to the City of Durham.
23	Section 2 of this act applies only to Durham County.
24	SECTION 4. Section 2 of this act becomes effective October 1, 2001. The
25	remainder of this act becomes effective when it becomes law.
