- 3 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
 - **SECTION 1.** G.S. 115C-238.29D(b) reads as rewritten:

5 "(b) The State Board shall authorize no more than <u>five-three</u> charter schools per 6 year in one local school administrative unit. The State Board shall authorize no more 7 than <u>100-135</u> charter schools statewide. If more than <u>five-three</u> charter schools in one 8 local school administrative unit or more than <u>100-135</u> schools statewide meet the 9 standards for final approval, the State Board shall give priority to applications that are 10 most likely to further State education policies and to strengthen the educational program

11 offered in the local school administrative units in which they are located."

12 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
