Abolition of alienation of affection cause of action. The common-law cause of action for alienation of affection of a spouse is 8 9 abolished." 10 **SECTION 2.** Chapter 52 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a 11 new section to read: 12 "§ 52-14. Abolition of criminal conversation cause of action. 13 The common-law cause of action for criminal conversation is abolished." 14 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law. This act does not affect cases pending when the act becomes law. 15
