A JOINT RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE ATLANTIC COAST CONFERENCE ON ITS FIFTIETH ANNIVERSARY AND HONORING THE MEMORY OF FORMER COMMISSIONERS JAMES H. WEAVER AND ROBERT C. JAMES. Whereas, the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) was founded on May 8, 1953;
and

Whereas, the original members of the ACC were Clemson University, Duke University, North Carolina State University, Wake Forest University, the University of Maryland, the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, and the University of South Carolina; and

Whereas, the University of Virginia joined the ACC in December of 1953, Georgia Institute of Technology joined in April of 1978, and Florida State University joined in July of 1991; and

Whereas, the University of South Carolina withdrew from the conference in June of 1971, the only school ever to do so in ACC history; and

Whereas, the ACC is one of the strongest conferences in the nation, having won 82 national championships, 40 in men's competitions and 42 in women's competitions; and

Whereas, many of the ACC's student-athletes have become All-Americans, Olympians, professional athletes, and coaches; and

Whereas, some of the ACC's top 50 male and female athletes include Michael Jordan, Tom Burleson, Arnold Palmer, David Thompson, Shane Battier, David Duval, Mia Hamm, Marion Jones, Andrea Stinson, and Julie Shea; and

Whereas, many of the ACC's student-athletes have also been outstanding in their classrooms and in their academic communities as caring volunteers and role models; and

Whereas, the success of the ACC is a fitting testimonial and memorial to the administrators of the conference, including former commissioners James H. Weaver and Robert C. James; and

Whereas, for 50 years, the ACC has provided thrilling sports entertainment to countless students, alumni, and fans; and

Whereas, North Carolina is the proud home to four of the nine ACC member universities; Now, therefore,

Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring:

SECTION 1. The General Assembly honors the memory of former ACC commissioners James H. Weaver and Robert C. James, congratulates and commends the Atlantic Coast Conference on its 50th anniversary, May 8, 2003, and expresses the appreciation of the citizens of this State to the athletes, coaching staffs, and commissioners, past and present, for their dedication to the athletic programs of the ACC.

SECTION 2. The Secretary of State shall transmit a certified copy of this resolution to John Swofford, Commissioner of the Atlantic Coast Conference.

SECTION 3. This resolution is effective upon ratification.
