8	education shall have the power or duty:

10	<u>(44)</u>	To Prohibit School Personnel from Recommending or Requiring the		
11		Use of Psychotropic Drugs or Central Nervous System Stimulants by		
12		Any Child Each local board of education shall adopt and implement		
13		rules and policies:		
14		a. <u>Prohibiting any school personnel from recommending the use</u>		
15		of psychotropic drugs or central nervous system stimulants by		
16		any child, and		
17		b. Prohibiting any school from requiring that a child take		
18		psychotropic drugs or central nervous system stimulants as a		
19		condition of attending the school.		
20		Rules and policies adopted pursuant to this subdivision shall not		
21		prohibit school personnel from recommending that a child be		
22		evaluated by an appropriate medical practitioner, or prohibit school		
23		personnel from consulting with such practitioner with the consent of		
24		the parents or guardian of such child."
